We are an alliance of more than **100 civil society organizations** that condemns Russia's war on Ukraine. We aim to support conscientious objectors, draft evaders, and deserters from **all countries affected by the war**: Russia, Belarus, Ukraine, and, therefore, demand

- the full implementation of the internationally recognized human right to conscientious objection
- protection and asylum for conscientious objectors, draft evaders, and deserters if they decide to leave their home country to flee abroad



We demand from the governments of Russia, Belarus, and Ukraine

 to stop the persecution of conscientious objectors and deserters immediately [which consists of repression and imprisonment, in Belarus even the death penalty]

We demand from the European Union

- to open their borders for refusers and war resisters
- to enhance asylum and protection mechanisms







Appeal to the German Parliament

Launched on March 29, 2022

Demand to

- grant asylum to Russian and Belarusian conscientious objectors under the Qualification Directive
- grant asylum to Ukrainian conscientious objectors who are evading acts that violate international law and who have been denied recognition as COs in Ukraine



Appeal to the European Union

Launched on June 9, 2022

- Second appeal to the European Parliament and the Parliamentarian
 Assembly of the Council of Europe that
- It was signed by 60 organizations from 20 countries
- Detailing why protection and support for deserters and conscientious objectors for people from the states involved in the war in Ukraine is necessary and right

Appeal

Protection and asylum for conscientious objectors and deserters from the states involved in the war in Ukraine

The European Parliament/Parliamentary Assembly of Council of Europe shall resolve

In light of the war in Ukraine, the European Parliament/Parliamentary Assembly of Council of Europe observes:

- the fundamental importance of Articles 1 and 2 of the United Nations Charter, which prohibit war of aggression and acts of war in violation of international law;
- the applicability of the Rome Statute, Article 25 of which imposes individual criminal liability for violations of Articles 1 and 2 of the Charter of the United Nations;
- recognition of the "Code of Conduct on Politico-Military Aspects of Security" adopted by the
 OSCE in 1994, in which all members of the armed forces are personally responsible for complying
 with international humanitarian law, and that members of the armed forces authorized to issue
 orders may not do so in violation of international law;
- that "the right to conscientious objection to military service inheres in the right to freedom of thought, conscience and religion. It entitles any individual to an exemption from compulsory military service if this cannot be reconciled with that individual's religion or beliefs. The right must not be impaired by coercion", as it has been recognized by the UN Human Rights Committee.¹
- that equivalently opposition to military service may also attract the guarantees of Article 9 concerning freedom of thought, conscience and religion, of the European Convention on Human Rights, as established by the European Court of Human Rights in its judgment of July 7, 2011, in



Petition to EU politicians


Initiated on September 9, 2022

- Online petition via the platform YouMoveEurope
- Initiated jointly by the European Bureau for Conscientious Objection (EBCO), War Resisters' International (WRI), International fellowship of Reconciliation (IFOR), and Connection e.V.
- Addressed to Ursula von der Leyen (President of the European Commission), Charles Michel (President of the European Council) and Roberta Metsola (President of the European Parliament)

So far, we've collected 49,711 signatures [as of November 2, 2023]

International action

On May 15, the International Day of Conscientious Objection

- In a joint high-profile action, we handed over almost 50.000
 signatures to the European Commission in Berlin
- This event was accompanied by speeches of national and international guests from Russia, Belarus, and Ukraine, additional actions, and festive music
- There were similar actions in at least 25 cities all over Europe
- We generated a great media echo




